### A/101 Aviation Association Memorial Scholarship

The A/101 Aviation Memorial Scholarship was established to provide financial assistance to graduating high school seniors and junior college students wanting to transfer to a 4 year college. All applicants must be either the children or grandchildren of someone who has served or is serving in Company A, 101 Aviation Battalion, 101 Airborne Division (Airmobile), or its antecedent unit designations. The scholarship of up to \$1,000 can be renewed through the application process. Funds are restricted to tuition, books and related fees. Award announcements are made in mid-July.

### **Eligibility Criteria:**

- Children (natural or adopted), step-children or grandchildren of an individual assigned to and who served, or continues to serve, with Company A, 101 Avn. Bn., including any antecedent unit designations and all future ones (the "Qualifying Sponsor"). The present unit designation is Company A, 4<sup>th</sup> Avn Bn, 101 Avn Regiment; and either
  - a. A high school senior applying to a four year accredited college or university anticipating graduation during the year of application who meets the grant criteria as listed below; or
  - b. A Sophomore, attending a community college, unmarried and under the age of 21 years at the time of application who meets the grant criteria as listed below, and is transferring to a four year accredited college or university.
- 2. Cumulative grade point average 3.2 GPA, or higher for high school seniors. Minimum 3.7 GPA for Community College Sophomores.
- 3. Completion of the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)

#### **Selection Criteria:**

- 1. Applicants must be able to show a financial need.
- 2. Receipt of all requested application material by the stated deadline. Follow all directions as stated on this form

#### **Scholarship Award:**

Up to \$1,000 each semester. The award will be split between two semesters. Prior recipients can reapply through the renewal application process.

#### Requirements:

The following must be returned to The A/101 Aviation Association and postmarked on or before **May 15**:

- Completed scholarship application
- Copy of DD-214 if the qualifying sponsor of the applicant is no longer in service (living or deceased); or, if still in service, a signed letter from the qualifying sponsor's commanding officer, attesting to that fact.
- Proof of a continuing participation in community service
- > Essay of no more than 500 words. The essay title and topic will be; "Why Serving One's Country in the Military is Important".
- Four (4) letters of reference: 2 from teachers/professors, 1 from a school/college guidance counselor and 1 from an individual respected in the community, such as; a church pastor, local government official, charitable organization head or scout leader. All letters must be from individuals unrelated to the applicant. (Please use the form provided.)
- An official cumulative *transcript* through the most recent term.
- Copy of the front page of the last two most recent family tax returns
- Financial Information Summary form completed by you and sent to the college or university you plan to attend.

It is the *responsibility of the applicant* to make certain that all requested material is sent to the Association.
