other LOH said, "The Cav. team bombarded the area with minigun fire and rockets. Later, an air strike was called in to finish the job."

"We must have hit about 15 hootches and four or five bunkers," added Santella. "Later, we followed the trail down a ridge line and hit several more hootches. Everywhere we turned there were more hootches."

In the second action of the day, the "Condor" troopers destroyed several more hootches and bunker complexes, just south of the DMZ.

According to Maj. William T. Hooten, Greenboro, Ark., the troop commander, "The trail on which these complexes were found is believed to be the northernmost infiltration route for the enemy in the Republic of Vietnam. We have reason to believe that this trail is a main enemy supply route."
