FORFMARD

This is the history of Company A, 101st Aviation Pattalion from 1 January 1765 through 31 August 1766. This period includes the ontire time Company A, 101st Aviation Battalian served in the Delta of the Republic of Vietnam. On 1 September 1766 the unit was redesignated as the 336th Aviation Company (Air Mobile Light) and the colors of Company A, 101st Aviation Battalian returned to Ft. Campbell, Kentucky and the home of the 101st Airborne Division.

Company A was formed as the airlift company of the ICLst Aviation
Battalion in 1962 at Ft. Campbell, Xentucky. The "Winged Warriors", as
they were micknamed, were the first men of the famed 101st Airborne Division to go into combat since World War II. They came to Soc Trang,
Vietnam in April 1965 and were attached to the 13th Aviation "Delta "
Battalion. Company A does not resemble any unit of the 101st Airborne
Division that fought in World War II. Nevertheless, in combat, the officers
and men of today have displayed the same spirit courage and professionalism
that was found in their predecessors. These ingredients have built the
reputation of the 101st Airborne Division throughout its history. To all
of these fighting men of the 101st Airborne Division, this supplement is
dedicated.
