Not all the action was found while flying on the "RF" or on the daily CAL missions. During the night, while the troops were in a relaxed mood, eating, watching a movie or sleeping, the loud shattering noises of incoming artillery or mortars were enough to rapidly send you towards the nearest bunker. On 1 July 1965, at 22h0 hours, the Vict Cong started their victous mortar attack on the grounds of Soc Trang Army Airfield. Rounds were falling on sections of the field, pilots and crows dashed out of their congregating places, and without regard to personal safety ran toward their respective helicopters, dodging and zigzawging to keep away from the effects of the mortar shells. Some personnel received wounds, and some helicopters were damaged, but those that were able to sustain flight were flown out of the area under attack. Air Medals with "V" devices were presented those soldiers and officers who under the rain of enemy fire, removed their aircraft from almost certain destruction.
